Librarian: Reference Services Department (part-time)

The Barberton Public Library is seeking a dynamic, creative, and motivated individual who will provide strong public library services, with an emphasis on outreach to seniors and homebound customers in our community. The Librarian position is part-time, scheduled at 28 hours per week. The Librarian works a flexible schedule, which will include nights and weekends on a rotating basis.

Under direction, the Reference Librarian will provide services to library customers, including reference, readers' advisory, and programming. Responsibilities will include general reference duties and collection development. The Librarian will select, checkout, deliver and pick up library materials to/from patrons' residences, nursing homes and assisted living facilities. The Librarian will work in multiple computer software applications including SirsiDynix, MS Office, Canva and PastPerfect.

The Barberton Public Library offers excellent benefits including vacation and sick leave, 11 paid holidays, Ohio Public Employees Retirement, health and life insurance and OLC membership.

Qualifications

A Master of Library and Information Science degree from an ALA accredited School of Library and Information Science required. A good working knowledge of classic and contemporary literature and reference materials is required. Experience in a public library setting working with seniors is preferred. Applicants with 6 credit hours or less towards completion of the M.L.I.S may also be considered.

Salary range

\$14.55 - \$21.24 per hour / 28 hours per week. Starting compensation depends on qualifications and experience.
